Fourteen years ago on January 7, 2006, East Palo Alto Police Officer Rich May was killed in the line of duty. His family was determined that Rich's death would not be in vain and the youth in East Palo Alto would have a place to play. The defense argued that there "was a lack of athletic opportunities, contributing to youth crime and gang activity."

BACKGROUND


The family created the Rich May Foundation with the goal of working with the Ravenswood City School District and the St. Francis of Assisi Church to build a full-sized all-weather lighted turf field for the community. The Rich May Memorial Field opened in 2016 – the lights were installed January 2019.

To date \$1.95M has been raised to build the field, including an initial grant of \$100,000 from the US Soccer Foundation.

The Rich May Memorial Field is open 7 days a week and used from morning to eight. We have capped the cost of renting the field at \$40/hour, significantly lower than our neighboring communities, to ensure that youth sports groups in East Palo Alto have opportunities to play, practice and excel. lundreds of players use the field each week for Rugby, Soccer and general all-around physical activity.
